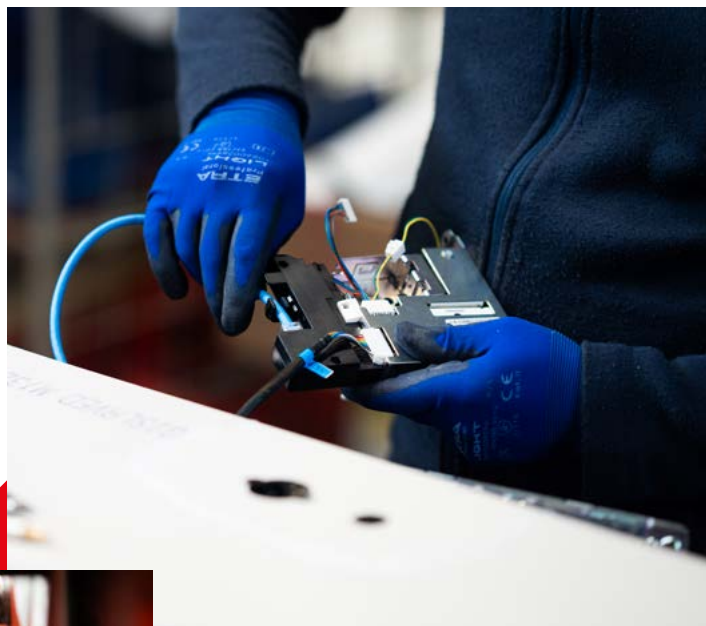

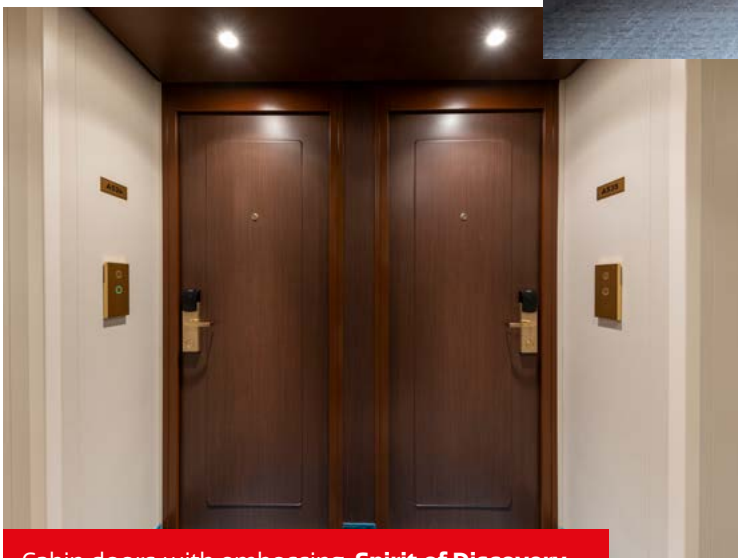
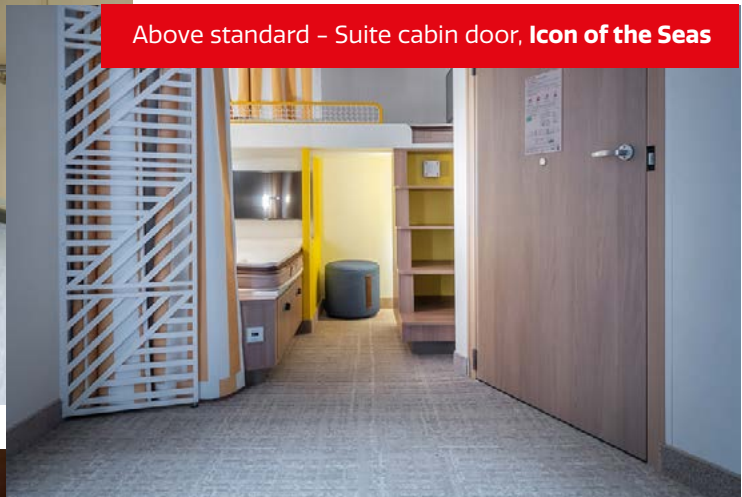

REPLACES LOOSE DOOR CABLES

The e-hinge is an invisible Ethernet cable system at sea. Traditional systems leave online cabling exposed and vulnerable to damage when the door is open.

Antti's innovation routes the cabling between the door leaf and the door frame directly through the e-hinge. Smart, functional, and safe.

Naturally, our doors meet the standards of fire-rated classes B and C.
